1. General

1.1. This Policy explains what data AINet (the “Service”, “Operator”) processes when providing access to Anthropic and OpenAI API models.

1.2. The Service is designed as a stateless API gateway with respect to content: the Operator does not store prompts, messages, files, instructions, or model outputs on its side.

1.3. The Service may apply technical access restrictions for specific user categories or use cases where required by applicable law, sanctions, export controls, or risk/anti-abuse policy. The Operator does not collect passport, citizenship, tax residence, or address information for KYC checks.

1.4. By using the Service, you confirm that you are allowed to use it under laws applicable to you and that you are not a person or organization prohibited from using the Service due to sanctions, export restrictions, court orders, administrative restrictions, or other mandatory restrictions.

2. Data Collected

2.1. Account Data

The Service does not request passport name, passport details, phone number, residential address, date of birth, government IDs, bank details, or biometrics.

2.2. Technical and Billing Data

Category	Contents
API request metadata	request_id, time, provider, endpoint, model, HTTP status, streaming flag, duration, token/image/web-search counters if available
API keys	short prefix and HMAC hash; the original key is not stored
Browser sessions	session token hash, creation and activity timestamps
2FA	encrypted TOTP secret, recovery code hashes

Billing	top-ups, debits, adjustments, internal balance, cryptocurrency payment identifiers
Legal/risk signals	country code from Cloudflare, if passed to the origin server

The AINet origin application does not store raw IP addresses or User-Agent values in request tables. Cloudflare and the hosting provider may process IP addresses as network and security providers.

2.3. Data Not Stored

The Service does not store on the Operator side:

- model request content;
- model response content;
- user-uploaded files as provider-side storage;
- raw user API keys;
- plaintext upstream OpenAI/Anthropic keys.

Production request/response body logging is disabled.

3. Purposes

Data is processed to:

1. register and sign in to the account panel;
2. record acceptance of legal documents;
3. issue and verify API keys;
4. route requests to Anthropic/OpenAI;
5. calculate usage cost and maintain prepaid balance;
6. apply rate limiting, fraud/abuse prevention, and security controls;
7. apply legal, risk, and anti-abuse restrictions;
8. support users and handle deletion requests;
9. comply with mandatory legal requirements.

4. Legal Bases

4.1. Account, session, and legal acceptance data are processed based on user consent and necessity to perform the Terms.

4.2. Billing, security, abuse prevention, and audit trail data are processed based on performance of the agreement, the Operator's legitimate interest in protecting the Service, and compliance with mandatory law.

4.3. If GDPR, UK GDPR, or similar regimes apply to you, you may exercise rights of access, rectification, erasure, restriction, objection, and portability by contacting the email above.

5. Third Parties

5.1. **Anthropic and OpenAI.** API request content is transmitted to the selected upstream provider to perform the request. The Operator does not have a Zero Data Retention agreement with Anthropic or OpenAI; their own policies apply.

5.2. **Cloudflare.** Used for DNS, CDN/WAF, Tunnel, and network security controls. Cloudflare processes IP addresses and HTTP metadata on its side.

5.3. **Cryptocurrency payment providers.** CryptoBot / Crypto Pay and, after merchant enablement, Heleket are used for cryptocurrency top-ups. The Operator receives technical invoice, status, amount, and currency identifiers required to credit balance.

5.4. **Hosting provider.** Provides server infrastructure.

5.5. Data is not sold, transferred to advertising networks, or used for behavioral advertising.

6. International Transfers

The Service uses infrastructure, API providers, and cryptocurrency payment providers outside the user's

country. By using the Service, you understand that request content and technical data may be transferred to the United States, the European Union, and other jurisdictions where Anthropic, OpenAI, Cloudflare, CryptoBot, Heleket, and hosting providers operate.

7. Retention

Category	Retention
Telegram/email/language account data	Until account deletion or justified deletion request
Legal acceptance records	While the account exists and as needed for dispute protection
Browser sessions	Until session expiry or logout
API keys	Until revocation/deletion; only hash and prefix are stored
Request/usage metadata	While the account is active and needed for billing, support, security, and disputes
Billing ledger	Retained as an append-only journal as needed for accounting, disputes, and mandatory law
TOTP/recovery	Until 2FA disablement or account deletion
Backups	Until natural backup rotation

8. User Rights

You may request access, correction, account deletion, withdrawal of consent, export of technically available data, or restriction of processing by contacting privacy@bytestrike.dev and identifying your Telegram User ID or @username.

Deletion does not affect data that the Operator is required or permitted to keep for billing, security, anti-abuse, dispute resolution, or mandatory legal requirements. Such data is minimized or anonymized where reasonably possible.

9. Cookies

The Service uses only technical cookies for sessions, CSRF protection, and interface settings. Advertising cookies and third-party advertising tracking are not used.

10. Age

The Service is for users aged 18 or older only. Accounts of minors may be blocked and deleted after detection.

11. Changes

The Operator may update this Policy. Material changes are published on the website and, where technically possible, notified in the interface or by email.
